NOTICE OF RACE

Rules: The race will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing, the proscriptions of US Sailing, except any of those that are altered by the Sailing Instructions, and by this Notice of Race.

Eligibility: The BYC Commodore's Cup race is open to all cabin boats (including sport boats and multis). We welcome everybody to attend this event. The most important part however is that you bring a lot of fun and sail fast, courteous and not overly aggressive.

Schedule:

Late registration – Boulder Marina	9:30 – 10:00 AM
Skipper's Meeting – Boulder Marina	10:00 AM
Start approximately	12:00 PM
Chili Supper will follow the Race (approximate)	5:30 PM

Skippers Meeting : is NOT mandatory (as long as you are signed up in advance). Check in with the CB on the lake. Listen to announcements over the VHF (68)

Course: The course will be depending on wind and lake conditions. We are planning a W/L course for all fleets

Sailing instructions: Instructions will be available on the day of the race at the skipper's meetings.

Fleets : We will have 4 Fleets : Sport boats/Multi, Spinnaker and JAM Wet and JAM Dry.

Starts : We will have two starts the Sport boats/Multi and Spinnaker fleet will start first , 5 minutes later we expect the JAM fleets to start .

Handicaps: Time-on-time handicaps will be used. We will use straight Phrf Numbers for the Sport boat/Multi and Spinnaker Fleet. JAM Wet and JAM Dry fleets will be racing under CYC JAM Phrf Numbers. Please check your Phrf number on the CYC Website, if your boat is not listed please let us know in advance so we can find the correct number for you well in advance of the event .

Alternative Penalties: The 720 Degree Turn Penalty Rule 44.1 and 44.2 of the racing rules will apply.

Closed Gate : The starting/finish line is closed during the race.

Prizes: Flags for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in all 4 fleets.

Marina Accommodations: AS USUAL for all Races and Parties slips are available at no cost to our friends and participants from around the lake. Thanks to Boulder Marina.
